

40-YEAR CEREMONY OF ESTABLISHMENT OF VIETNAM FILM INSTITUTE AND RECEIVED BY THE PRIME MINISTER'S COMMITTEE (1979 - 2019)

On the morning of September 20, 2019, at 523 Kim Ma, Ba Dinh, Hanoi, the Vietnam Film Institute solemnly held the 40th Anniversary of Vietnam Film Institute and received the Prime Minister's Certificate of Merit. 40 years ago, on September 22, 1979, the Vietnam Film Institute (originally called the Vietnam Film Documentation Institute) was established under Decision No. 343 / CP of the Government Council. This milestone marks the birth of one of the nation's largest animation archive centers. Since its establishment, generations of leaders and the collective of officials and employees in each period have always tried, tried their best, overcame all difficulties to successfully fulfill the tasks that the Party and the House. countries entrusted.

After a period of 40 years of construction and maturation, from a unit with initial material facilities still inadequate, backward, the staff is still thin, to this day, Vietnam

Film Institute has been The assessment is a reputable animation archiving center in the region with nearly 200 employees, workers and two large storage facilities in Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City. The new national animation archive at Thach That, invested and built by the Ministry of Culture, Sports and Tourism, has been put into use. The national animation collection is kept in two warehouses of Vietnam Film Institute in Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City with the number of films stored about 80,000 16mm and 35mm films, tens of thousands of video tapes of all kinds. , with nearly 20,000 movie titles. With the attention of the Ministry of Culture, Sports and Tourism of Vietnam,0 C - humidity 30% - 35% and is considered one of the best movies warehouse in Southeast Asia.

In addition to upgrading facilities and equipment to meet the increasing demands of the digital technology era, the Institute's staff are increasingly rejuvenated and regularly fostered. Expanding foreign relations, strengthening foreign cooperation to bring the position of Vietnam Film Institute into rapid integration with the new and modern trend of archiving institutes in the region and in the world. Currently, Vietnam Film Institute has been an official member of two international organizations: Federation of International Film Archive Institutes (FIAF) and Southeast Asia-Pacific Audiovisual Archive Association (SEAPAVAA).
